**Artworth** in partnership with Innresponse.

Funded a Board Development Project for organizational structure, operations, financial and strategic planning, **and on-going program evaluation.**

**Amount: \$ 5,000.00**

Funded a set of curling stones to accommodate the growing youth curling program.

**Amount: \$4,670.00** (includes \$2,000.00 from OECYR Fund)

**Campbellford Business Improvement Area (BIA)** in partnership with The Municipality of Trent Hills.

Funded the purchase of Christmas wreaths for the lamp-posts in the downtown and waterfront areas.
