The following overview highlights the diverse and unique nature of the Community Foundation projects to be completed in 2006

Campbellford BIA

In partnership with the Municipality of Trent Hills. Funded the purchase of 60 banners and hardware to be installed on lampposts in the downtown and waterfront area.

Amount: \$6,535.20

Campbellford District High School

In partnership with the Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board. Funded upgrading the lighting and sound equipment for the School Auditorium.
