
As a Community Foundation, we have an intimate understanding of local needs and opportunities, and we take the broadest possible view of what a community is, and what a community needs to succeed.



Smart & Caring Community Funds provide the opportunity for residents to invest in solutions, to give back to their hometown in return for a good life, to thank the community that helped them succeed.



WARKWORTH Smart & Caring Community Fund (Warkworth/Percy)

Led by community members, donations of all sizes are pooled into the Smart & Caring Community Fund to support organizations and projects in that community for generations.

A \$1 Million Smart & Caring Community Fund could potentially provide \$35,000 in grants for community priorities annually. As it grows so will its grant making capacity!

This "Give Where You Live" philosophy will help ensure that each community can respond to its needs through access to their own granting program, just like we do in Campbellford/Seymour.



CAMPBELLFORD/SEYMORE COMMUNITY FUND

Since 2003, The Campbellford/Seymour Community Foundation has provided over \$3.7 million in grants for projects and programs for the Campbellford/Seymour Community. The community has benefited from improved playgrounds, park benches, talking books, upgraded ball diamonds and soccer fields, sports team uniforms, x-ray tables, musical instruments, gardens, grasslands and shade trees, a splash pad and a skatepark, wetlands, waterfronts, and job opportunities for youth - and so much more.

Here's the magic of an endowment fund - the CSCF started with \$6.2 million, has provided over \$3.7 million in grants, and still had a fund balance of \$6.75 million as of December 31, 2017.

Anyone can be a donor and contribute a gift, large or small, to a Smart & Caring Community Fund designated for their community. Donations are invested and professionally managed, and income from the investment is used to make grants back to the community.

More and more, donors are looking for ways to give effectively and meaningfully to their favourite causes and charities in their community.


The Campbellford/Seymour Community Foundation is here to help!
