Greetings!

Here at the community foundation, our sole purpose is building community, and in doing so we are pleased to announce our 2022 grants. This year we are awarding:

- Eight **Community Impact Grants** totaling \$35,181.81, which includes \$200.00 from the [Glover Family Fund](#),
- Eight **Job Opportunity for Youth Grants** totaling \$39,800.00,
- One **Children & Youth in Recreation Grant** for \$3,752.82,
- and a **Municipal Fund Grant** of \$74,781.81

That's a total of \$153,516.44, bringing our total grants since 2003 to over \$4.2 million!

As a community foundation, we provide grant funding to local registered charities and partnering not-for-profit organizations, for projects that seed, nurture and support community initiatives in the areas of arts and culture, education, youth, recreation, environment, health & wellness, social services, and community development.

The **Community Fund** at the Campbellford/Seymour Community foundation is primarily used to support projects that benefit and enhance life for residents of the Campbellford/Seymour community. **Community Impact Grants** and **Job Opportunity for Youth Grants** are allocated from the Community Fund.

2022 Community Impact Grants

Bike Action Trent Hills in partnership with the Rotary Club of Campbellford – \$5,000.00 to support the transition from an adhoc group to a thriving and sustainable community organization.

Campbellford & District Mental Health in partnership with Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation – \$4,400.00 to purchase workbooks, self-soothing kits and a subscription to "Psychology Tools" for their same day counselling program. This includes \$200 from the [Glover Family Fund](#).

Campbellford District High School in partnership with KPR District School Board – \$4,781.81 to purchase woodworking tools and equipment to meet the hands-on learning needs of students exploring the skilled trades.

Campbellford Memorial Hospital – \$5,000.00 to engage an outside strategic planner to assist in a community scan to create a plan for primary-care recruitment and retention.

IncrEdible Trent Hills in partnership with Innresponse - \$4,800.00 to initiate gardening and cooking classes for Grade 8 students of Kent and Hillcrest Public Schools.

IODE Bemersyde Chapter in partnership with the National Chapter of IODE Canada – \$3,000.00 to install a reflection bench at the site of the Campbellford/Seymour Cenotaph for all to sit and honour our veterans in quiet remembrance.

Scientists in School – \$3,200.00 to support STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) enrichment through community workshops at the Campbellford Branch Library and classroom programs at St. Mary Catholic Elementary School.

Wholistic Learning Alliance in partnership with Innresponse – \$5,000.00 to raise awareness and strengthen actions around climate change through the presentation of three community workshops at the Aron Theatre.

2022 Job Opportunity for Youth Grants

In an effort to address the specific community need of youth employment, the **Job Opportunity for Youth** initiative was developed in 2012. It provides charitable and not-for-profit organizations with grant funding to hire a student for a summer placement to complete specific projects that will directly benefit their organization and to provide youth with

marketable skills and local economic opportunities. To date, we have provide 80 jobs for local youth!

Aron Theatre Cooperative in partnership with Innresponse – \$5,000.00 to hire a Youth Engagement Manager to help design, organize and market special movies and events at the theatre for young people.

Artworth Trent Hills Art Camp in partnership with Innresponse – \$4,800.00 to hire two Assistant Camp Coordinators to coordinate teen volunteers and assist camp participants with their art projects.

Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation – \$5,000.00 to hire a Development Officer Assistant to work with staff to advance their giving programs, plan special events, and assist with communications initiatives.

Community Care Northumberland – \$5,000.00 to hire an Office Assistant to help with administration duties, support programs, special projects, and learn about client assessments and referrals.

Community Living Campbellford/Brighton –\$5,000.00 to hire a Resource Centre Activity Assistant to plan a summer calendar of activities for people supported by CLCB.

Compass Early Learning and Care/ Beehive Hillcrest – \$5,000.00 to hire an Early Childhood Education Assistant to work in all areas of a daycare setting, assisting in the supervision of children ages birth to 12 years old.

Promised Land Animal Sanctuary – \$5,000.00 to hire a Farm Hand and Tour Assistant to help with the care of their resident animals, as well as help with special events and visitor tours.

Westben Arts Festival Theatre – \$5,000.00 to hire a Customer Service Associate to help in the office and at the venue during performances.

2022 Children & Youth in Recreation Grant

This grant is awarded from our [Ontario Endowment for Children & Youth in Recreation Endowment Fund](#). This fund supports grants for recreational projects and programs for children and youth in the Campbellford/Seymour community.

- **St. Mary Catholic Elementary School** – in partnership with PVNCCDSB – \$3,752.82 to purchase science materials to support exploration of the natural environment and hands-on learning, as well as athletic equipment to encourage sport and connection.

2022 Municipal Fund Grant

The **Municipal Fund** at the Campbellford/Seymour Community Foundation was created with half of the proceeds of the sale of the Town of Campbellford's 100-year-old public utility and is for projects determined by the Municipality of Trent Hills.

The Municipality of Trent Hills – \$74,781.81 towards the new Campbellford Recreation & Wellness Centre – which increases our total to \$923,188.21 for the \$1.5 million commitment from the Municipal Fund.
